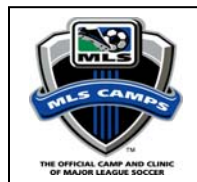

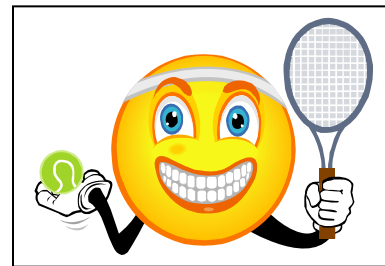

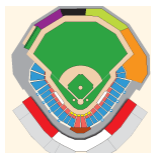

On Saturday, June 14th, 2008 The Double Creek Bike Tour & Half Marathon/5K race will be taking place. The race will start at 7am at the North Salem Elementary School and follow the roads indicated in red and yellow on the map below.
