Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

METAL:

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Steel food & beverage cans, aerosol cans, paint cans

GLASS:

 Clear, brown, blue, and green glass food & beverage containers

PLASTIC:

- #1 through #7 All materials must be thoroughly cleaned before placing them in your recycle container.
- Remove caps/lids
- Rinse thoroughly to remove
- all contaminants
- It is OK to leave on labels and neck rings

PAPER, PAPERBOARD & CARDBOARD:

Recycle Any Size. Any Quantity.

Please break down boxes as flat as possible and put them out next to your recycle bin(s) on your pick-up day.

- All sizes of cardboard boxes
- Clean pizza boxes
- · Food boxes (i.e. cereal & gelatin boxes)
- EMPTY paper towel and toilet paper rolls
- Paperboard packaging (i.e. tissue boxes)
 Office paper (any color)
- · Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines, catalogs, and brochures
 Envelopes & junk mail
- Paper bags
- Phone books & other soft cover books
- Paperboard food and drink cartons
- Remove all packaging (Styrofoam, peanuts, plastic bubble wrap, plastic liners, etc.)
- Flatten ALL boxes Bundle all cardboard that does not fit into the recycling bin
- Cover loose paper with heavier items to prevent it from blowing away
- If the weather forecast calls for high winds or wet weather, if possible, keep your paper recyclables until next week. Wet paper products are difficult to process.

DOVER TOWNSHIP RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Acceptable Items—Aluminum food and beverage containers, Glass food and beverage containers-brown, clear or green, Bi-Metal, Steel and Aerosol cans, PET Plastic Containers with the symbol #1 narrow neck containers only, HDPE Plastic containers with the symbol #2 narrow neck containers such as milk and water bottles, detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles, etc. without caps, Plastics with symbols #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 narrow and screw top containers, Newsprint, Cardboard-flattened in 2'x2' bundles (may be placed in recycling bin along other recycling), Residential mixed paper (Junk Mail, Magazines, Telephone Books, Printer/Copier Paper) Cereal Boxes.

Non-Acceptable Items- Window or Auto Glass, Drinking Glasses, Mirrors, Light Bulbs, Ceramic, Porcelain, Microwave Trays, Glass Cookware/Bakeware, Unnumbered Plastic Items, Plastic Bags, Salad/Deli Containers, Shredded Paper, Plastic Food Tubs, Household Items such as cooking pots, Batteries, Cardboard/Paper with wax coating or liners, Scrap Metal, Siding.



Place your brush along the public (township or state) road before 7 A.M. on the date for your area of the township.

Brush should be within 5 feet of the curb or edge of road. If the ground is soft or wet, we cannot reach the brush without causing damage to your property. Length of the brush should be less than 8' long and 8" in diamteter. Avoid placing brush behind, near, or around obstacles such as poles, mailboxes, etc. Do not park in front of or on top of brush pile. Stumps will not be collected.
