The York County Planning Commission is conducting a survey to determine how the public feels about our local waters -- keeping our streams clean or, in some cases, cleaning them up; flooding issues; recreational uses; and doing our part to help clean up the Chesapeake Bay.

The human body is 65% water and our survival is dependent upon an ample supply of **clean water** for drinking, bathing and to nourish our crops. Clean water also provides opportunities for swimming, fishing and boating. But, unfortunately, polluted streams can be found throughout the County.

Did you know that, over the next three years, York County is required to reduce the amount of pollution entering its streams by an amount equal to more than 10,000 dump truck loads?
