#### **Industrial & Commercial Development Committee**

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. #### **Planning Commission**

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five-member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five-year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, **2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

#### Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, <u>851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania</u>, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Wednesday of the month.

#### **DOVER TOWNSHIP RECYCLING GUIDELINES**

Acceptable Items—Aluminum food and beverage containers, Glass food and beverage containers-brown, clear or green, Bi-Metal, Steel and Aerosol cans, PET Plastic Containers with the symbol #1 narrow neck containers only, HDPE Plastic containers with the symbol #2 narrow neck containers such as milk and water bottles, detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles, etc. without caps, Plastics with symbols #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 narrow and screw top containers, Newsprint, Cardboard-flattened in 2'x2' bundles (may be placed in recycling bin along other recycling), Residential mixed paper (Junk Mail, Magazines, Telephone Books, Printer/Copier Paper) Cereal Boxes.

Non-Acceptable Items- Window or Auto Glass, Drinking Glasses, Mirrors, Light Bulbs, Ceramic, Porcelain, Microwave Trays, Glass Cookware/Bakeware, Unnumbered Plastic Items, Plastic Bags, Salad/Deli Containers, Shredded Paper, Plastic Food Tubs, Household Items such as cooking pots, Batteries, Cardboard/Paper with wax coating or liners, Scrap Metal, Siding.

## Question from a concerned resident: What benefits do I receive from my quarterly sewer bill?

You are paying for the transportation and treatment of the wastewater that comes from your home. Wastewater is that dirty, yucky water that goes down your drains and away from your home. It is water that has been contaminated by soap, detergents, shampoo, food particles, fats, lint, hairs, urine, fecal matter, toilet paper, and anything else that goes down the drain or flushed down the toilet. Each household creates about 250 gallons or more of this dirty water every day. Wastewater is transported from homes by a series of pipes called sewers. These pipes vary in diameter size from 8" near your home to 42" near the plant. The collection crew of the wastewater department is responsible for the maintenance and operations of the sewer mains in the streets and rights-of-way.

Your treatment plant processes this wastewater, creating two final products: clean water that is discharged into the Little Conewago Creek and biosolids that is recycled as agricultural land amendments. Treatment is a complex mixture of physical, chemical, and biological processes. The facility must operate around the clock, every day of the year. Operations are strictly regulated and monitored by state and federal agencies. The wastewater department follows a Continual Improvement Program to proactively monitor and control our efficiency and costs while ensuring the continual reliability of the transportation and treatment systems. Your sewer fees pay for the operation, maintenance, repairs, and administration of the systems as well as cost of construction of all upgrades and expansions. # VOLUNTEERS NEEDED Courtesy of the Dover Township Fire Chief

For over 60 years Dover Township has been protected by volunteers who serve as firefighters. Like so many other area Departments we, at times, struggle to have adequate staffing to accomplish all the tasks involved with an emergency situation. Our volunteers respond to events during and after severe weather events, any type of reported fire, car accidents with and without injuries, traffic control situations, transfers to other areas while they are busy on an emergency, mutual aid response to much of York County for various Rescue situations, search details, water rescue, trench rescue, industrial accidents, farm accidents, medical emergencies at the request of the ambulance, and the list goes on and on. On average, we respond to about 2 calls for service per day.

Currently these activities fall mostly on the shoulders of our "live in" members and a few responders who come from home. We have a very short list of administrative members who spend countless hours paying the bills, helping with fund raising and attempting to secure new members. We rely heavily on mutual aid responses from fire departments that surround our community to assist on any structure fire in our Township. We sincerely appreciate the support that they give us.

In total, each year to pay for repairs and maintenance, cover all insurances, pay off loans for apparatus, fuel, replace broken/worn out equipment, provide training for members and replace personal protective equipment, as well as put money into savings toward replacement of apparatus every 20 years, our total budget is right around \$600,000 per year. Tax money provided by the Township is around \$190,000 per year, State Firefighter Relief funding is right around \$126,000 per year and the rest falls to us to raise. Currently, no one in this organization receives any monetary compensation for any time that they volunteer. Should the volunteer system fail and career staffing be required to fulfill the gap of 3 firefighters providing coverage 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year; the additional cost burden to tax payers would be a conservative number of \$1 Million per year.

Now, with all this being said, we currently have about 14 active members in our Department. We need your support. We realize the commitment because we all live it every day. We juggle family and work to make it work. Please consider volunteering your time to help with administrative duties, fire police duty, fund raising or firefighting activities. Please feel free to stop at the station for a visit, pick up an application and let us know that you support this organization.

Since 1958, Dover Area Ambulance Club, Inc. (DAAC) has been committed to providing the highest quality Basic Life Support Service to everyone in our area. DAAC is NOT associated with any local Fire Department and is a nonprofit ambulance service. DAAC does not receive ANY local tax subsidy. We rely on donations from the Community and billing to offset the high costs of the service. DAAC staffs two ambulance daily with paid EMT's. DAAC runs around 2100 calls a year.

DAAC will write off what insurance won't pick up, once copays have been paid.

If you have no insurance, a subscription offers a discount of 15% on services.

You will receive a bill from Healthcare Management Control (HMC) in Lancaster. You can submit the bill to your insurance company or give your insurance information to HMC, so they can bill your insurance direct. Your subscription covers the portion of the bill your insurance does not pay, after the third party providers have been billed.

The Subscription does not cover yearly deductibles that you are "required" to pay.

This subscription is good for three (3) 911 responses including refusal of services.

A participating subscriber shall be entitled to "emergency" ambulance service by Dover Area Ambulance Club, when available, to the closest hospital emergency room in our response area, providing the hospital is not on divert and is accepting patients.

# Flu season is coming, PREPARE!

CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine as the first and most important step in protecting against flu viruses.

While there are many different flu viruses, a flu vaccine protects against the viruses that research suggests will be most common.

Everyone 6 months of age and older should get a flu vaccine.

People at high risk:

Young children, Pregnant Women, Chronic health Conditions of Heart, Lung and Diabetes
People 65 Years and Older

Vaccination is also important for health care workers, and other people who live with or care for high risk people to keep from spreading flu to them.

#### **EVERYDAY PREVENTION**

- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
- While sick, limit contact with others as much as possible to keep from infecting them.
- CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone except to get medical care or for other necessities.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
- WASH YOUR HANDS often with soap water. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Germs spread this way.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with germs like the flu.




