

We also suggest that you place your mailbox on the side of your driveway away from approaching traffic to allow our driver to properly clear the roadway and to get as close as possible to your mailbox to minimize the amount of shoveling you will have to do to clear the mailbox for the postal carrier.

Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, **2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, **851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.




The Dover Township Volunteer Fire Department will be holding their annual "Breakfast with Santa"

YORK COUNTY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY

York County Solid Waste Authority's Residential Electronics Recycling Program is free and open to York County residents ONLY and is conducted **Monday thru Friday from** 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. And Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The program is conducted in the parking area located

directly across from the York County Resource Recovery Center which is located at 2651 Blackbridge Road.

Ways for Residents to **Conserve Water**

- 1. Turn off water while brushing your teeth.
- 2. Have someone who you think is taking too long for a shower? Place a kitchen timer in the bathroom and set it. When the timer goes off, it's time to get out of the shower.
- 3. Put a $\frac{1}{4}$ or $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon container filled with water in the tank area of your commode (avoiding the float/trap area). In this manner, every time you flush and the tank refills, it will have to fill that much less.
- 4. Only do dishes or laundry when you have a full load.
- 5. During a drought, save dish or bath water to water the garden plants.

DOVER TOWNSHIP BULK ITEMS GUIDELINES

Dover Township residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week through curb side collection. Please have your waste, recycling and bulk item available for collection at the curb by 6 AM. A bag of trash does not count as a bulk item. **Accepted Materials**

Appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4-foot rolls of carpet (tied).

Non-Acceptable Materials

Electronic Waste (computers, televisions, etc.) chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

Additional Instructions

Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Dover Sewer Crew Project NOTIFICATION

Palomino Interceptor Replacement

On November 30, 2017, Dover Township Sewer Authority received bids for the replacement of 10" transite pipe with new 18" pvc pipe. The project extends from Thornton Automotive to Davidsburg Road. The lowest bidder was Anrich, Inc. with the amount of \$764,893.00. The project's substantial completion date is early summer of 2019. Should you have any questions or concerns about this project, please contact Dover Township's collection crew chief at (717) 292-3634.

Joint Interceptor Replacement

The first phase is immediately upstream of the Dover Wastewater Treatment Plant. The replacement includes 6,210 linear feet of 42-inch pipe with 54-inch pipe, 19 manholes and a confluence chamber at manhole J01003. This is where the Fox Run Interceptor joins into the Joint Interceptor. This phase is under contract and in the late stages of design. Permitting and ROW work is being completed with bidding expected in October 2018.

North of the Borough Sewer

This project is intended to eliminate I&I (inflow & infiltration) and Dover Township sewer from going to the Dover Borough treatment plant. It will replace an old 8" clay line with new 8" PVC. This project starts in our industrial area (Raycom). It will extend to Carlisle Rd and up to George St, where we will be installing a sewage pumping station. It will also go out Harmony Grove Road approximately 520 feet. This project is under contract and in the late stages of design. Permitting and ROW work is being completed with bidding expected in early 2019.



Since 1958, Dover Area Ambulance Club, Inc. (DAAC) has been committed to providing the highest quality Basic Life Support Service to everyone in our area. DAAC is NOT associated with any local Fire Department and is a nonprofit ambulance service. DAAC does not receive ANY local tax subsidy. We rely on donations from the Community and billing to offset the high costs of the service. DAAC staffs two ambulance daily with paid EMT's. DAAC runs around 2100 calls a year.

SUBSCRIPTIONS DO NOT COVER SERVICES PROVIDED BY LOCAL ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNITS (ALS). DAAC SUBSCRIPTIONS DO NOT COVER TRANSPORTS BY ANY OTHER AMBULANCE SERVICE. WHEEL CHAIR VAN SERVICES ARE A SEPARATE SERVICE AND NOT COVERED.

Subscriptions Coverage and Benefits:

Did you know that some insurance companies do not pay for ambulance service as part of their benefits? You will want to see what your coverage is.

DAAC will write off what insurance won't pick up, once copays have been paid.

If you have no insurance, a subscription offers a discount of 15% on services.

You will receive a bill from Healthcare Management Control (HMC) in Lancaster. You can submit the bill to your insurance company or give your insurance information to HMC, so they can bill your insurance direct. Your subscription covers the portion of the bill your insurance does not pay, after the third-party providers have been billed.

The Subscription does not cover yearly deductibles that you are "required" to pay.

This subscription is good for three (3) 911 responses including refusal of services.

A participating subscriber shall be entitled to "emergency" ambulance service by Dover Area Ambulance Club, when available, to the closest hospital emergency room in our response area, providing the hospital is not on divert and is accepting patients.
