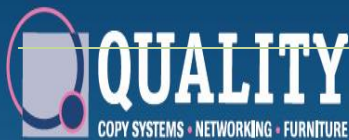

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Township Municipal Building, **2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, **2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania**, at 4:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, **2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, **851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

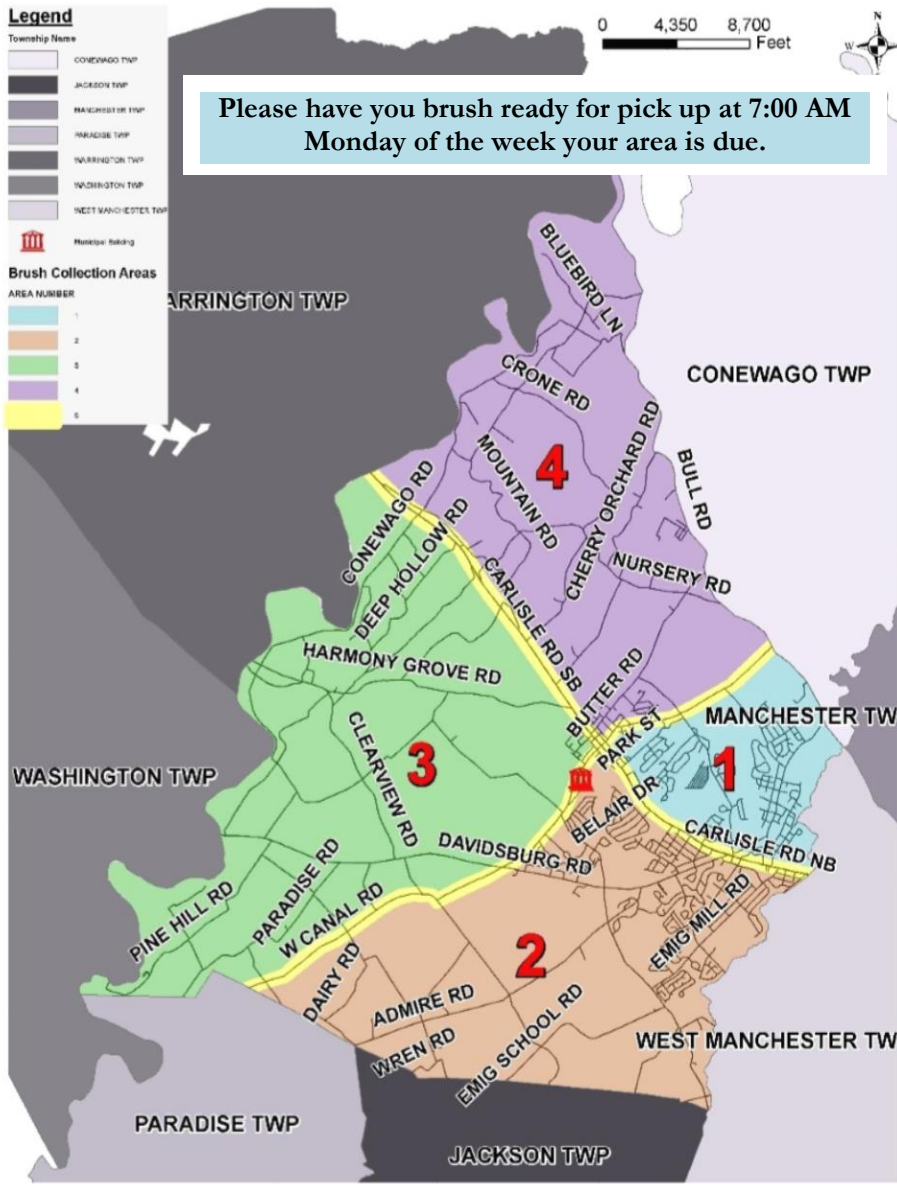

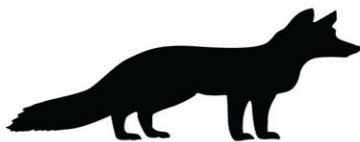

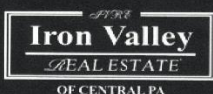

DOVER TOWNSHIP BULK ITEMS GUIDELINES

Dover Township residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week through curb side collection. Please have your waste, recycling and bulk item available for collection at the curb by 6 AM. A bag of trash does not count as a bulk item.

Accepted Materials

Appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4-foot rolls of carpet (tied).

Non-Acceptable Materials

Electronic Waste (computers, televisions, etc.) chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

Additional Instructions

Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS LIST

Please do not place any of these items in your recycling bin!
 Penn Waste does not accept the following items for recycling.



NO PACKAGING

Including bubble wrap, styrofoam peanuts, plastic packing pillows, and foam packaging inserts.



NO MEDICAL WASTE

Medical waste is a health hazard and should be disposed of properly in your trash.



NO PLASTIC BAGS

Return these to retail or grocery stores.



NO CLOTHING OR LINENS

Donate usable items to charity or reuse worn items as rags.



NO SMALL APPLIANCES OR EXTENSION CORDS



NO FOIL PRODUCTS

Including aluminum foil and foil serving trays.

Please empty and rinse all containers.

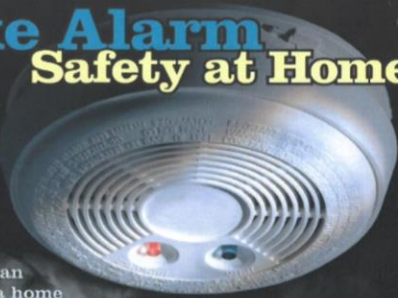

Smoke Alarm Safety at Home



Smoke alarms are an important part of a home fire escape plan. When there is a fire, smoke spreads fast. Working smoke alarms give you early warning so you can get outside quickly.

SAFETY TIPS

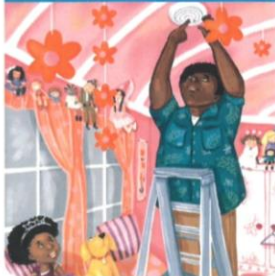
- ❑ INSTALL smoke alarms inside every bedroom, outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home, including the basement.
- ❑ Larger homes may need ADDITIONAL smoke alarms to provide enough protection.
- ❑ For the best protection, INTERCONNECT all smoke alarms so when one sounds they all sound.
- ❑ An IONIZATION smoke alarm is generally more responsive to flaming fires and a PHOTOELECTRIC smoke alarm is generally more responsive to smoldering fires. For the best protection, both types of alarms or a combination alarm (photoelectric and ionization) are recommended.
- ❑ INSTALL smoke alarms following manufacturer's instructions high on a wall or on a ceiling.
- ❑ REPLACE batteries in all smoke alarms at least once a year. If an alarm "chirps," warning the battery is low, replace the battery right away.
- ❑ REPLACE all smoke alarms when they are 10 years old or sooner if they do not respond properly when tested.
- ❑ FIRE WARNING EQUIPMENT is available to awaken people who are deaf or hard of hearing. This equipment uses strobe lights and vibration equipment (pillow or bed shakers) for people who are deaf and mixed-low-frequency signals for people who are hard of hearing. Some of this equipment is activated by the sound of the smoke alarm.

FACTS

- ❑ Roughly **two thirds** of home fire deaths happen in homes with no smoke alarms or no working smoke alarms.
- ❑ Working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home fires in **half**.

AND DON'T FORGET...
All smoke alarms should be tested at least once a month using the test button.

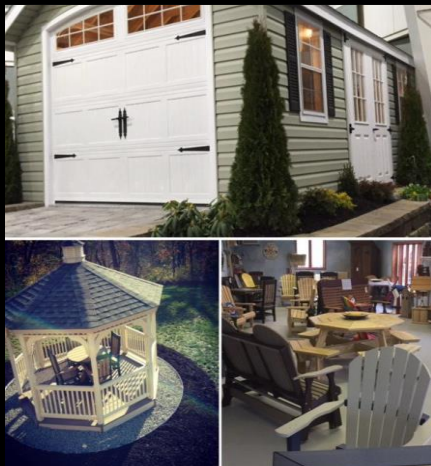

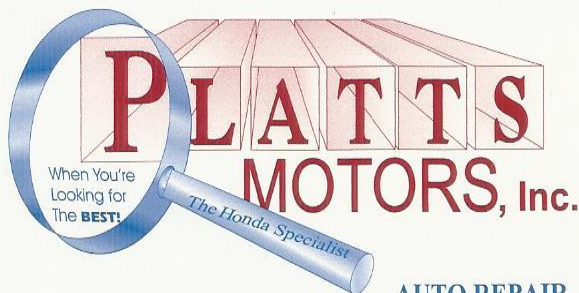

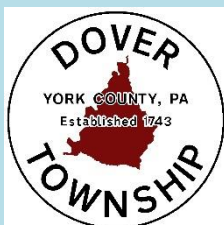

Dover Township Sewer Projects

Palomino Interceptor Replacement

On November 30, 2017, Dover Township Sewer Authority received bids for the replacement of 10" transite pipe with new 18" pvc pipe. The project extends from Thornton Automotive to Davidsburg Road. The lowest bidder was Anrich, Inc. with the amount of \$764,893.00. The project's substantial completion date is early summer of 2019. Joint Interceptor Replacement

On January 18, 2019, Dover Township Sewer Authority received bids for the replacement of 42" concrete pipe with new 60" HP pipe. The first phase is immediately upstream of the Dover Wastewater Treatment Plant. The replacement includes 6,210 linear feet of 42-inch pipe with 60-inch pipe, 19 manholes and a confluence chamber at manhole J01003.

This is where the Fox Run Interceptor joins the Joint Interceptor. The first phase also includes work inside of the waste water treatment plant at the headworks. The lowest bidders were Anrich, Inc., Garden Spot Electric, and Garden Spot Mechanical with the total amount of \$6,817,711.00. The project's substantial completion date is the summer of 2020. North of the Borough Sewer

This project is intended to eliminate I&I (inflow & infiltration) and Dover Township sewer from going to the Dover Borough treatment plant. It will replace an old 8" clay line with new 8" PVC. This project starts in our industrial area (Raycom). It will extend to Carlisle Rd and up to George St, where will be installing a sewage pumping station. It will also go out Harmony Grove Road approximately 520 feet. This project is under contract and in the late stages of design. Permitting and ROW work is being completed with bidding still expected in late 2019.

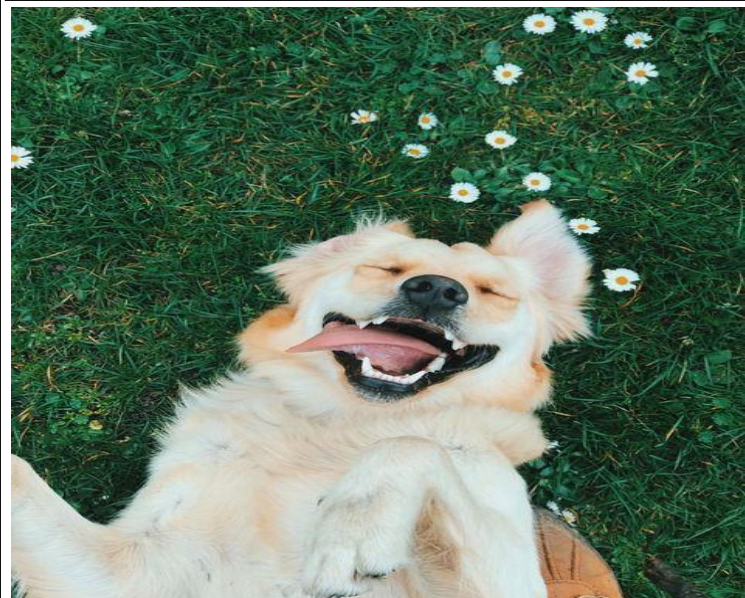

Resident Water and Sewer Billing Reminder



Please note:

FAILURE TO RECEIVE A BILL DOES NOT VOID RESPONSIBILITY FOR ITS PAYMENT OR WAIVE THE PAST DUE PENALTY.

The water and sewer bills come out quarterly.

A 10% penalty is imposed on the current charges not paid by the due date. All water and sewer bills are due by the 15th of the month unless the 15th falls on a weekend or holiday. If the 15th falls on a weekend or holiday, the due date will be the following business day.

A rate change for water services went into effect on January 1, 2019. The rate for residential water service is \$39.00 for the first 6000 gallons of water usage. Every additional 1000 gallons will be billed at \$5.90/1000 gallons.
