**A RESOLUTION OFFERING SUPPORT TO TOWNSHIP BUSINESSES,
THE YORK COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AND
NORTHERN YORK COUNTY REGIONAL POLICE DEPARTMENT
ASSOCIATED WITH REOPENING ASSOCIATED WITH COVID-19**

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2020, the York County District Attorney provided guidance to not prosecute non-compliant businesses in York County, during the red or yellow status of the state's phased reopening plan associated with COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Northern York County Regional Police Department following the guidance of the York County District Attorney, will not criminally charge, but engage and educate, non-compliant businesses while York County is in the red and yellow status of the state's phased reopening plan associated with COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the reopening of the economies of York County and Dover Township would support the reopening of businesses who wish to open, but not require it; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dover Township Board of Supervisors, York County, Pennsylvania, fully supports Township businesses wishing to open and feel they have CDC guidelines in place, also supports the positions established by the York County District Attorney and Northern York County Regional Police Department; and




