## Street Obstructions & Overhanging Tree Limbs

On July 27, 2020, the Dover Township Board of Supervisors approved Ordinance 2020-06 authorizing amendments to Chapter 21, Parts 5 and Parts 6 regarding Street Obstructions and Overhanging Trees. Some of the obstructions have been defined as the following:

- Basketball nets/hockey goals within street right-of-way
- 2. Tree Limbs hanging <u>lower</u> than 15' over the street cartway or 9' above a sidewalk
- 3. Dumpsters/storage containers illegally parked on the street
- 4. Mulch/construction materials/grass clippings placed on public streets
- 5. Unattached trailers parked in the street

An update to this Ordinance will allow the Township to more effectively deal with violations of this Chapter. General motorists need a safe, unobstructed way to navigate the streets of Dover Township while delivery trucks, tractor trailers, and RV's need an unobstructed lane of travel free of overhanging limbs. # Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00pm on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

#### **Planning Commission**

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipal Code of the Commonwealth Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal West Building, 2480 Canal Road. Dover. Pennsylvania, at 7:00pm on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

#### **Sewer Authority**

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00pm on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.


- \*Polls are open on election day from 7am to 8pm
  - \*Last day to register to vote: October 19, 2020
- \*The deadline to register to vote is now 15 days prior to an election, rather than 30 days.

What to bring:

If you've voted at your polling place before, you don't need to show ID to vote.

If you're a first-time voter, or if you moved within Pennsylvania and are voting for the first time at a new polling place, you must show ID to vote. Acceptable forms include: Pennsylvania driver's license or Penn-DOT ID card; ID issued by Pennsylvania or the US government; US passport; US military ID; student ID; employee ID; a confirmation issued by the County Voter Registration Office; non-photo ID issued by Pennsylvania or the US government; firearm permit; or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or a government check that includes your name and address.



# HAZARDOUS WASTE CAUSES TRUCK FIRES

NEVER PLACE THE BELOW ITEMS IN YOUR CURBSIDE TRASH & RECYCLING.

#### **NO POOL CHEMICALS**

Pool chemicals are extremely combustible which is why they cannot be disposed of in your curbside trash and recycling bins. To dispose of them, check with the store you bought them from to see if they have any resources for disposal. You could also donate them to a local pool or check with your local solid waste authority to see if they accept them.





#### **NO RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES**

Rechargeable batteries can easily start fires when combined with the right materials. Never place these in your curbside collection bins. Several retailers such as Lowe's, Home Depot, and Target offer drop-off programs. You can also check with your local solid waste authority to see if they accept them.

#### NO LIVE AMMUNITION

Live ammunition should never go in your curbside trash and recycling. Check with local law enforcement, indoor gun ranges, or your local solid waste authority to see if they accept live ammunition.





#### **NO PROPANE TANKS**

Propane tanks are extremely flammable and should never be disposed of in your curbside trash and recycling bins. Contact your local solid waste authority to see if they accept them or ask the vendor you bought it from if they will take them back.

#### Yard Waste Guidelines

for Dover Township Residents

#### Yard Waste Is...

material such as tree trimmings, shrubbery and other organic landscape vegetation not listed below.



#### How to Prepare Yard Waste

- Place yard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
  - Bundles may be no longer than 5 feet in length.
  - Bundles may not weigh more than 30 pounds each.
  - Branches may not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- Once prepared, yard waste must be placed at the curb on scheduled pick up day before 6:00 am.
- An unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.

#### DO NOT place these items out for yard waste collection:

Grass Clippings Fruits & Vegetables Tree Stumps









Please prepare your yard waste properly. Yard Waste in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected!

## Joint Interceptor Replacement



Dover Township Sewer Authority received bids for the replacement of 42" concrete pipe with new 60" HP pipe. The first phase is immediately upstream of the Dover Township Wastewater Treatment Plant. The replacement includes 6,210 linear feet of 42-inch pipe with 60-inch pipe, 19 manholes and a confluence chamber at manhole J01003. This is where the Fox Run Interceptor joins the Joint

Interceptor. The first phase also includes work inside of the Wastewater

Treatment Plant at the headworks. The lowest bidders were Anrich, Inc., Garden Spot Electric, and Garden Spot Mechanical with the total amount of \$6,817,711.00. The project's substantial completion date is the Summer of 2021. ## Water Main Replacement Project

This project is intended to replace the aging water lines on Belair Dr and Raycom Rd in Dover Township. It will replace the old 6" line with a new 8"



line on Belair Dr and replace the old 8" line with a new 12" line on Raycom Rd. Along with the water main, all service lines will be replaced to each home between the main and the curb shut off. This project is currently in the design phase with construction to take place in the Fall of 2020 to the Spring of 2021. You may experience scheduled interruptions to your water service during the construction phase of this project if you live on or near these roads.

## Residential Yard Waste Options

#### Option 1- Monthly Curbside pick-up offered by Penn Waste

Items must be bundled with twine or placed in a biodegradable bag.

- Bundles may be no longer than 5 feet in length and weigh no more than 30lbs. with branches not exceeding 6 inches in diameter.
- Items must be placed curbside by 6:00am on scheduled pick up day.

#### Option 2- Brush Drop-off located behind the Township Municipal Building

- Open the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of every month from 7am-4pm for Township Residents Only. (Must provide ID)
- No Trash or Commercial Contractors

# Fall Leaf Collection



Fall Leaf Collection for 2020 will begin the week of November 9th and continue until mid-December or the first measurable snow.

Leaves shall be placed curbside. Foreign substances deposited in with leaves such as residential trash, tree limbs, shrub and hedge trimmings or stone will NOT be collected.

Sometimes Mother Nature does not cooperate with our schedule, either the leaves do not drop from the trees early enough or snow arrives before we are able to finish with the leaf collection. In this case, township residents can bring their (unbagged)leaves to the brush drop-off location on Municipal Road the second and fourth Saturdays of each month from 7am-4pm.

The safety of our crews is very important, so please use caution when passing work crews along the roadways.

#### **DOVER TOWNSHIP WATER AND SEWER CUSTOMERS**

Please make sure that Dover Township has your correct contact information, such as your phone number and email address. We will use this information to contact you regarding any emergencies that would affect your services or to contact you regarding your utility bill or water usage. #### **WATER LEAKS**

Research has shown that water leaks can lead to 2,000—20,000 gallons of water being wasted each day. The 7 most common areas where leaks occur are:

- \* SHOWERS/BATHTUBS \*TOILETS (ESPECIALLY THE FLAPPER IN THE TANK)
- \* SINKS, FAUCETS, HANDLES AND PIPES \* DISHWASHERS
- \* CLOTHES WASHERS \* WATER HEATERS \* OUTSIDE SPIGOTS.

You can check for water leaks by using your water meter. Read the meter before you go to bed or will be away from the house for a period of time. Read the meter again when you wake up or return home. If the numbers have changed without any water being used, there is a leak somewhere in the house.

The majority of water leaks in a house are caused by running toilets. A good way to check for a leaky/running commode is with a simple dye test. Put some dark colored food coloring in the tank of the toilet and let it sit. Do not flush the toilets. After a couple of hours, check the toilet again. If any of the colored water from the tank is now in the bowl, you have a leaky toilet.

#### **WAYS TO CONSERVE WATER**

Turn off the water when brushing your teeth.

Use a kitchen timer to limit the amount of time in the shower.

Place a liter bottle filled with water in the tank of the commode, avoiding the float and trap area.

Only do dishes or laundry when you have a full load

During the summer dry spells, save bath and dish water to water the garden or plants.
