Public Meetings

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00pm on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

INDUSTRIAL & COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00pm on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

PLANNING COMMISSION

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00pm on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

SEWER AUTHORITY

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00pm on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Andover Utility Replacement Project

On December 14th, 2020 the Dover Township Supervisors approved a proposal for Spotts, Stevens, and McCoy to design, bid, and award the Sanitary Sewer and Water replacement in Andover. This is one of Dover Townships older developments. The goal is for construction to being in Spring of 2022. This project will include the replacing of all Sanitary Sewer and Water mainlines. This

project will also include the replacement of all Sanitary Sewer laterals and Water service lines to the Township right-of-way. This project will take the place of our annually cured in place projects.



North of the Borough Sewer

This project is intended to eliminate Inflow & Infiltration and Dover Township sewer from going to the Dover Borough treatment plant. It will replace an old 8" clay line with new 8" PVC. This project starts in our industrial area (Raycom). It will extend to Carlisle Rd and up to George St, where it will be installing a sewage pumping station. It will also go out Harmony Grove Road approximately

520 feet. This project is under contract and in the late stages of design. Permitting and Right of Way work is being completed with bidding expected in 2021.

Disposal of Grass Clippings

Do not dump your grass clippings or yard waste in drainage channels, drainage easements, streams or creeks. In addition to environmental issues with this debris being dumped illegally, you are causing drainage issues for your neighbor by blocking drainage channels.



Dover Township Brush Drop Off

Dover Township operates a Brush Drop Off two Saturdays out of the month directly behind the Municipal Building at the future location of Eagle View Park. With the development of the park fast approaching, we need to make our residents aware that this service is unlikely to be able to continue at the park location. Currently, the Drop Off allows residents to bring their brush to our facility for disposal; however, our staff then must reload the brush and haul it to **Spring Valley Mulch located at 2470 Mill Creek Road**, **Dover** or **H and H Mulch located at 660 Old Hanover Road**, **Spring Grove** for final disposal. These facilities **WILL** accept brush from residents directly for no cost. We are asking our residents to plan for hauling their brush to one of these locations in the coming months as it is anticipated that Park Improvements will be open by no later than the summer of 2022.

Fall Leaf Collection

• Leaves must be raked to the curb or roadside no further than 5' back, so they are accessible to the equipment used to vacuum the leaves.

 Please do not place brush, grass clippings or bamboo out with your leaves. Our equipment is not designed to vacuum long or heavy items and could damage the equipment.

• You may cover your leaf piles if you choose so your leaves do not blow away.

• Please do not place your leaf piles near street signs, utility poles or mailbox's.

Our crews will not drive onto the property to pick up leaves.

• Any remaining leaves will need to be raked back out to the roadside for pick up.

The safety of our crews is very important, so PLEASE use caution when passing work crews along the roadways.

Letting a faucet drip during extreme cold weather can prevent a pipe from bursting. Only pipes vulnerable to freezing (ones that run through an unheated or unprotected space) should be left with the water flowing.

The use of space heaters, electric heating tapes and cables in areas that have exposed water lines can regulate the temperature and prevent freezing. However, these methods must be used with extreme caution to avoid the risk of fire.

A Note from Dover Area Ambulance Club:

There seems to be confusion on the location of emergency services in Dover and where monies are being donated. Dover Ambulance (DAAC) is located at 40 East Canal Street in Dover Borough alongside the Dover Borough Fire Department we have been here at this address since 1988 and in the Borough Fire Department since our start in 1958. We service Dover Township, Dover Borough, Conewago Township, also portions of Warrington Township and any other neighboring communities as emergency calls require.

DAAC is the Basic Life Support (BLS) ambulance residing in the Dover Area. We are dedicated to 911 service only and do not go out of service to do non-emergency transports. DAAC is NOT financially affiliated with the area fire stations. There is no BLS ambulance on Davidsburg Road at the Dover Township Fire Department, but does house a Community Life Team (York), "chase" paramedic unit that responds to life threatening 911 emergencies, that require a paramedic for Advanced Life Support care (ALS) such as cardiac and respiratory problems. The ALS unit is not a transporting unit and is not financially affiliated with Dover Ambulance DAAC.

You will find the yearly Ambulance Subscription/Donation Card above. This is DAAC's only fundraiser each year and is a tax deductible contribution.
