REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONDUCT OF APPROVED FIRES_

- 1. It shall be prohibited to conduct outdoor burning in any zoning district other than the Conservation (CV) district and the Agricultural (A) district.
- 2. No person under the age of eighteen (18) shall be permitted to regulate, manage or control an outdoor burning.
- 3. No person shall conduct an outdoor burning within one hundred fifty (150') feet of any building or structure.
- 4. No person shall conduct an outdoor burning within twenty-five (25) feet of any adjoining property line.

NOTIFY COUNTY CONTROL, 854-5571, ASK FOR FIRE DISPATCHER WHEN BURNING.

- 5. No person shall conduct a burning on any public or private street, street right-of-way, alley, road or highway.
- 6. No person shall conduct a burning of any items, at any time, for the purpose of disposal, that may be accommodated through services provided by the Township or a designee, including but not limited to household garbage, tires, plastic, furniture, dimensional or stained wood, pallets, cars, car parts, batteries, mattresses, wire, animals, shingles, construction debris, and large item pickup.
- 7. No person shall conduct a burning consisting of a structure.
- 8. Any person desiring to conduct an outdoor burn must first obtain a burn permit, unless otherwise indicated under this Ordinance. The application for a burn permit shall be made to the Township's Fire Chief or his/her deputies, who shall review and approve or deny the application within two (2) business days.
- 9. All outdoor burning shall be kept under competent and continuous supervision.
- 10. All flammable and combustible materials not in use as a fuel for a burn shall be moved a sufficient distance from the burn so as not to constitute a hazard.
- 11. Proper notification shall be made to the York County Emergency Center (911) of the time, place and period of an outdoor burning. Notification shall also be made to York County 911 when the outdoor burn is completed.
- 12. All fires, ashes and coals shall be thoroughly extinguished after the use thereof has been completed and must be extinguished before sundown.
- 13. Exemptions: the following activities are exempt from the outdoor burning restriction:
 - A. Outdoor burnings done in conjunction with school-related or civic functions such as bonfires, group wiener roasts or campfires provided that:
 - 1) Such burnings are conducted under adult supervision (twenty-one years of age or older)
 - 2) Such burnings are extinguished by midnight of the same day
 - 3) A burn permit is obtained (no fee will be assessed for the issuance of a permit under this subsection).
 - B. An outdoor burning is permitted in any zoning district when contained within an approved appliance (for example: barbeque grills, fire bowls or rings, chimneys, turkey roasters). A burn permit is not required under this subsection.
 - C. An outdoor burning related to Agricultural Use as that term is defined in the Township's Zoning Ordinance. A burn permit is required under this subsection.
