Public Meetings

Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority and guide line of operational decision is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month AS NEEDED. Please check www.dovertownship.org for details and updates on scheduled meetings.

Interactive Zoning Map Adds FEMA Layer

Due to substantial flooding which occurred in 2021, we have added the FEMA floodplain layer to our interactive zoning map. Flood zones are delineated by the Regulatory Floodway (red striped area); the Base Flood Elevation (BFE - blue) which represents the 1% annual chance of flood, otherwise known as the "100-year flood"; and the 0.2% annual chance of flood (orange) – otherwise known as the "500-year flood". Strict building and floodplain requirements are associated with these hazard areas in order to not further impact the waterways or cause obstructions during a flooding event among many other reasons. If you live in one of these areas and/or are planning a project within a floodplain, please contact our staff to discuss the necessary requirements. Illegally working within a floodplain or floodway could result in local, state, and even

federal enforcement.

LANDLORD/TENANT ISSUES & RESPONSIBILITIES

As a general rule, Dover Township does not get involved with landlord/tenant issues. That said, we have looked at ways to ensure landlords are providing adequate and safe housing to their tenants through a rental registration/inspection program. The Board of Supervisors have weighed the pros and cons of adopting this type of program while trying to balance the resources available to administer it. While the program is not moving forward at this time, Dover Township will be gathering publicly available resources to help guide tenants to the appropriate agencies if they need assistance or cannot afford legal representation. Please visit our website to access these resources as they become available. Violations under the Dover Township Property Maintenance Code will continue to be enforced. Please contact us at 717-292-3634 with any questions.

Andover Utility Replacement Project

The Dover Township Board of Supervisors on December 13, 2021, accepted a proposal from Doli Construction Corp. to replace/upsize the sanitary sewer and water facilities within the entire Andover Development. Work has begun and is scheduled to be substantially complete December 31, 2022. Substantially complete meaning all mainlines and lateral connections to the street right of way. A final completion date of May 1, 2023 is intended for all trench paving and yard restoration. Spotts, Stevens and McCoy (SSM) are the engineer on the project. The estimated cost for the new utility lines is \$2,868,755. Repaving of the streets will occur under a separate contract and will be scheduled for the Summer/Fall of 2023. To view the tentative project schedule that we have received from the contractor please see the Township website. This is always subject to change due to weather and unforeseen events.





Joint Interceptor Phase 2/3 Replacement Project

On January 26, 2022, the Dover Township Sewer Authority approved a proposal for Buchart Horn to design, bid, and possibly award the replacement of 10,350 LF of sanitary sewer interceptor line. The replacement is necessary to replace sixty plus year old concrete pipe, also to up size the line due to additional flow from developments in West Manchester and Dover Townships. This project will go from the east side of Bull Rd to the west side of Carlisle Rd. This is one of Dover Townships largest and longest interceptors. The goal is for construction to being in late 2022 and be substantially complete in the beginning of 2024. This project will include the replacing of all sanitary sewer lines and manholes.

A Message from the Water Department...


Dover Township will begin flushing fire hydrants in the month of April. During this time, you may experience sputtering faucets and cloudy/dirty water. This is due to air that has entered the line and the stirring up of sediment that has coated the mains. This is normal and to alleviate the problem, let your

faucet run for 3 to 5 minutes.

NEW WATER/ SEWER RATES

Water and sewer bills are sent out quarterly.

If your old account number starts with a **0** or **1**, your bills are issued in **January**, **April**, **July and October**

If your old account number starts with a **2 or 6**, your bills are issued in **February**, **May**, **August and November**

If your old account number starts with a **3**, your bills are issued in **March, June, September and December**

Bills are issued on the 1st of the month and are always due by the 15th of the month, unless the 15th falls on a weekend or holiday, in which case the due date would be the next business day.

- · Quarterly residential charges for public sewer are \$128.52 · Quarterly charges for a grinder/garbage disposal are \$5.50
- · Quarterly charges, based on a standard 3/4" service line, for public water are \$45.00 for up to 6000 gallons of water.

 Additional charges for usage over 6000 gallons are
 \$6.83/1000 gallons.

A message from Dover Area Ambulance Club

Dover Ambulance is ready for Spring!

We ran 2330 calls in 2021, our highest call volume in our 64 year history. DAAC is proud to say we are still dedicated to our communities 911 needs and do not go out of service to do routine transports.

The end of January 2022, we took possession of a new 2022 Ford Ambulance that was delayed due to chassis availability. This ambulance is equipped as a full complement bariatric system with a winch, loading ramps and a bariatric litter, to safely move patients. We wrote a grant which supplied the money to get this equipment.

Last fall, a grant sponsored by Blue Shield was written and we received funding towards two new Stryker Pro power cots at \$22,000 each and three stair chairs at \$3000 a piece.

They were placed in service and are a great addition to our fleet of equipment.

Our goal is to put two ambulances in service to cover the community 911 responses in our area. Dover Ambulance thanks you for your continued support and donations. Always appreciated.
