Public Meetings

Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority and guide line of operational decision is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month AS NEEDED. Please check www.dovertownship.org for details and updates on scheduled meetings.


Street Obstructions & Overhanging Tree Limbs

Street obstructions can cause safety issues, impacting the lane of travel for motorists and first responders. Some of the street obstructions have been defined as the following:

- Basketball nets/hockey goals within street right-of-way
- Dumpsters/storage containers illegally parked on the street
- Mulch/construction materials/grass clippings placed on public streets
- Unattached trailers parked in the street

Overgrown trees can block sight at intersections and overhang traffic signs, impairing one's ability to see oncoming traffic or possibly a stop sign. A detailed diagram for tree maintenance has been included below for reference.

Motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists need a safe, unobstructed way to navigate the streets of Dover Township while delivery trucks, tractor trailers, and RV's need an unobstructed lane of travel free of overhanging limbs. NEW WATER/ SEWER RATES

Water and sewer bills are sent out quarterly.

If your old account number starts with a **0** or **1**, your bills are issued in **January**, **April**, **July and October**

If your old account number starts with a 2 or 6, your bills are issued in February, May, August and November

If your old account number starts with a **3**, your bills are issued in **March**, **June**, **September and December**

Bills are issued on the 1st of the month and are always due by the 15th of the month, unless the 15th falls on a weekend or holiday, in which case the due date would be the next business day.

- Quarterly residential charges for public sewer are \$128.52
 Quarterly charges for a grinder/garbage disposal are \$5.50
- · Quarterly charges, based on a standard 3/4" service line, for public water are \$45.00 for up to 6000 gallons of water.

 Additional charges for usage over 6000 gallons are \$6.83/1000 gallons.



Research has shown that water leaks can lead to 2,000—20,000 gallons of water being wasted each day.

The 7 most common areas where leaks occur are: showers/bathtubs, toilets, sinks, dishwashers, washer, water heaters, and outside spigots.

Do NOT place these items out for yard waste collection:

How to Prepare Yard Waste: Place your yard waste in

- L.Place your yard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
 - Bundles may be no longer than 5 feet in length.
 - Bundles may not weigh more then 30 pounds each.
 - Branches may not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- Once prepared, yard waste must be placed at the curb on your scheduled pick up day before your collection time.
 An Unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.

Project Lifesaver



Project Lifesaver provides law enforcement with a program designed to protect, and when necessary, quickly locate individuals with cognitive disorders who are prone to the life threatening behavior of wandering. The necessity of this program was determined through the correlation between cognitive conditions and the act of wandering. The program has grown from a localized program to a program recognized internationally as a proven and effective method of "bringing loved ones home."

The method relies on proven radio technology and specially trained search and rescue teams. Citizens enrolled in Project Lifesaver wear a small transmitter on the wrist or ankle that emits an individualized frequency signal. If an enrolled client goes missing, the caregiver notifies their local Project Lifesaver agency, and a trained emergency team responds to the wanderer's area. The first responders will then use the client's individualized frequency to locate the position of the individual.

The Northern York County Regional Police Department has nine officers trained in the operation of the Project Lifesaver Program. Four of these officers are School Resource Officers.



HANDLING MARKET Volatility

Conventional wisdom says that what goes up must come down. But even if you view market volatility as a normal occurrence, it can be tough to handle when it's your money at stake. Though there's no foolproof way to handle the ups and downs of the stock market, the following common sense tips can help.

Don't put your eggs all in one basket

Diversifying your investment portfolio is one of the key ways you can handle market volatility. Because asset classes often perform differently under different market conditions, spreading your assets across a variety of investments such as stocks, bonds, and cash alternatives (e.g., money market funds, CDs, and other short-term instruments), has the potential to help reduce your overall risk. Ideally, a decline in one type of asset will be balanced out by a gain in another, but diversification can't eliminate the possibility of market loss.

Focus on the forest, not on the trees

As the market goes up and down, it's easy to become too focused on day-to-day returns. Instead, keep your eyes on your long-term investing goals and your overall portfolio. Although only you can decide how much investment risk you can handle, if you still have years to invest, don't overestimate the effect of short-term price fluctuations on your portfolio.

Don't stick your head in the sand

While focusing too much on short-term gains or losses is unwise, so is ignoring your investments. You should check up on your portfolio at least once a year, more frequently if the market is particularly volatile or when there have been significant changes in your life. You may need to rebalance your portfolio to bring it back in line with your investment goals and risk tolerance.
