Public Meetings

Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipal Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority and guide line of operational decision is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, 2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month AS NEEDED. Joint Zoning Update



Dover Township & Dover Borough are currently updating their zoning ordinances in accordance with the 2020 Comprehensive Plan. The ordinance update has been mostly funded through a grant from the York County Planning Commission through the obtainment of federal funds, otherwise known as a Community Development Block Grant. The aim of

the update is to look at new types of uses that have entered the marketplace in the last 10-15 years and provide applicable definitions & criteria for these types of uses. We are also aiming to make our zoning uses & definitions more complementary between the Borough and the Township while also updating existing use standards. Please watch Savvy Citizen for additional Planning Commission meetings pertaining to

the zoning update.

Dover Township Leaf Collection 2023

THE BACKGROUND EQUIPMENT WAS PURCHASED WITH DEP 902 RECYCLING GRANT FUNDING. THIS UNIT WILL NOT ONLY HELP WITH THE SAFETY OF OUR PUBLIC WORKS CREWS BUT IT WILL ALSO DECREASE THE NEEDED MANPOWER FOR LEAF COLLECTION MOVING FORWARD. PUBLIC WORKS CREWS WILL BEGIN COLLECTING LEAVES STARTING OCTOBER 30TH THROUGH THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 4, 2023. PROVIDE DIRECT ACCESS TO THE LEAVES BY PARKING VEHICLES AWAY FROM THE PILES. LEAVES SHOULD BE PLACED ALONG THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY. DO NOT PLACE LEAF PILES BEHIND OR AROUND OBSTACLES SUCH AS TREES, MAILBOXES, POLES, ETC. LEAVES THAT ARE INACCESSIBLE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED. DO NOT PUT BRANCHES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, BRUSH, OR ANY DEBRIS UNDER OR IN THE LEAF PILE. THIS WILL CAUSE MAJOR DAMAGE TO THE EQUIPMENT AND DELAY THE COLLECTION. THERE IS NO SET SCHEDULE FOR THE LEAF COLLECTION CREWS SO PLEASE BE PATIENT AND REFRAIN FROM CALLING INTO THE TOWNSHIP. WE WILL DO OUR BEST TO PICK YOUR LEAVES UP IN A TIMELY MANNER. STAY UP TO DATE AND GET ALERTS ABOUT LEAF COLLECTION WITH THE SAVVY CITIZEN APP!

Yard Waste Guidelines

For Dover Township Residents

Yard Waste is...

material such as tree trimmings, shrubbery and other organic landscape vegetation not listed below.



Do NOT place these items out for yard waste collection:

How to Prepare Yard Waste:

- 1. Place your yard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
 - Bundles may be no longer than 5 feet in length.
 - · Bundles may not weigh more then 30 pounds each.
 - · Branches may not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- 2. Yard waste must then be placed at the curb on your scheduled yard waste pick up day before your collection time.
- 3. An Unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.

- Car tires only No Rims! (2 tires = 1 bulk item)

- 1. No items that are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will be collected
- 2. Additional trash bags ARE NOT considered bulk items!
- 3. Call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection of all bulk items.
- 4. Please have your bulk item curbside the evening before your scheduled collection day.

Unacceptable:

- Automobile parts
- Car & Truck batteries

Project Lifesaver



Project Lifesaver provides law enforcement with a program designed to protect, and when necessary, quickly locate individuals with cognitive disorders who are prone to the life threatening behavior of wandering. The necessity of this program was determined through the correlation between cognitive conditions and the act of wandering. The program has grown from a localized program to a program recognized internationally as a proven and effective method of "bringing loved ones home."

The method relies on proven radio technology and specially trained search and rescue teams. Citizens enrolled in Project Lifesaver wear a small transmitter on the wrist or ankle that emits an individualized frequency signal. If an enrolled client goes missing, the caregiver notifies their local Project Lifesaver agency, and a trained emergency team responds to the wanderer's area. The first responders will then use the client's individualized frequency to locate the position of the individual.

The Northern York County Regional Police Department has nine officers trained in the operation of the Project Lifesaver Program. Four of these officers are School Resource Officers.





A NOTE FROM DOVER AMBULANCE CLUB

Started by the Lions Club in 1958, DAAC is a Nonprofit, Basic Life Support Ambulance Service for Dover and the surrounding communities for 64 years. Two paid EMT's staff the ambulance 24/7 at 40 East Canal Street in Dover Borough. DAAC is NOT associated with the two Dover Fire Departments. DAAC does not receive tax subsidies and relies on your continued support thru subscription and tax deductible donations to offset the costs of providing 911 ambulance service.

What are the benefits of a subscription?

Your support helps EMS to continue to provide 911 service with equipment repair, upkeep and purchases of new equipment as needed. Includes "3" responses during the subscription year. Eliminates expenses under certain circumstances for falls, refusals and non-transports normally \$200 fee included in three calls a year. On 911 transports, we cannot write off copays, deductibles and coinsurances, as this is your agreement with your chosen insurance provider for your portion of the bill. Subscription works in conjunction with insurance, check to see what your insurance covers, this subscription is not for a free ride. DAAC will bill your insurance company and send you a copy of the bill. When the check for your service arrives please pay your bill promptly, to avoid further actions with collections. If there is no insurance payment on the bill or no insurance, a 10% discount will be offered off the bill. This is for DAAC services only, we do not reciprocate. A subscriber shall receive "Emergency" 911 ambulance service by Dover Ambulance (DAAC), when available, with transport to the closest hospital in our responding area of your choice usually York or UPMC Hospitals. We greatly appreciate your support as we are not tax dollar supported.


