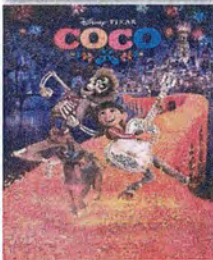

Planning Commission

The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Plan of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Township Municipal Building, **2480 West Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, **851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania**, at 7:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

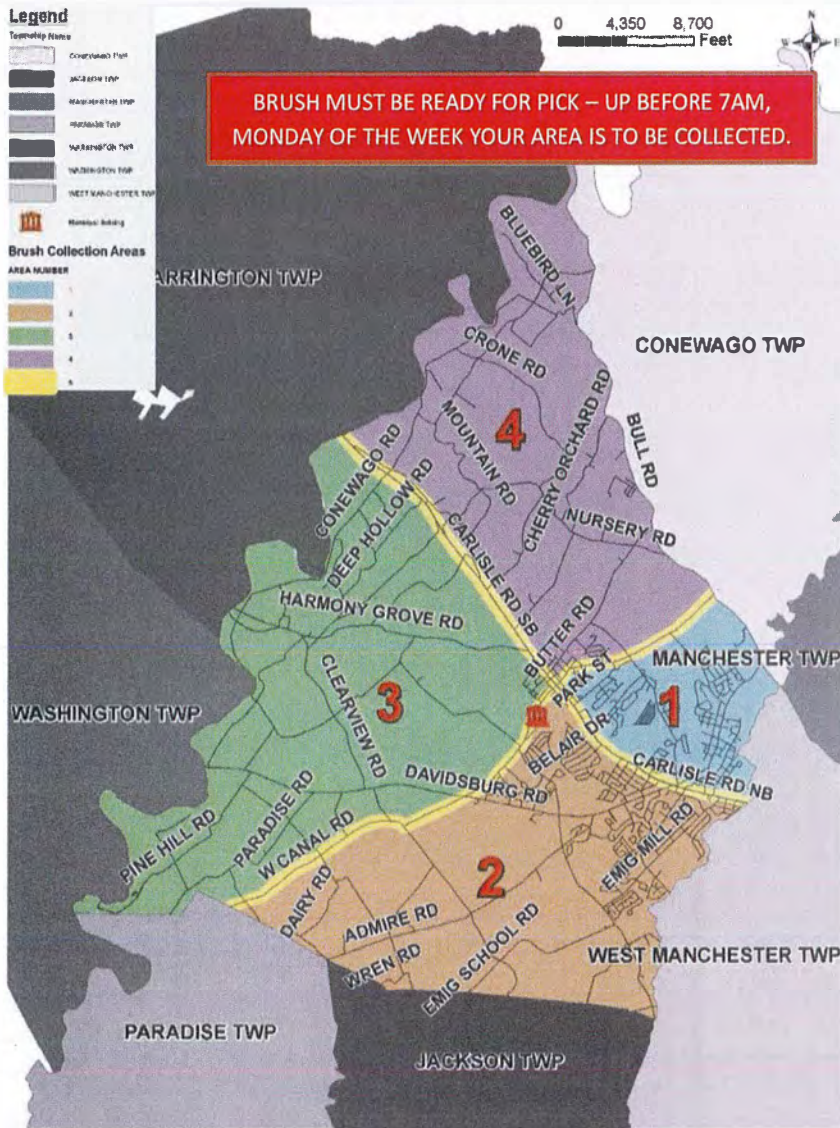

FALL BRUSH COLLECTION 2018

AREA # 1

September 17, 2018

Area between East Canal Road from Dover Borough to Bull Road and Carlisle Road from Dover Borough to the West Manchester/Dover Township border will be collected this week.

AREA # 2

September 24, 2018

Area between Carlisle Road from Dover Borough to the West Manchester/Dover Township border and West Canal Road from Dover Borough to the Paradise Township/Dover Township border will be collected this week.

AREA # 3

October 1, 2018

Area between West Canal Road from Dover Borough to the Washington Township/Dover Township border and Carlisle Road from Dover Borough to the Warrington Township/Dover Township Border.

AREA # 4

October 8, 2018

Area between Carlisle Road from Dover Borough to the Warrington Township/Dover Township Border to East Canal Road from Dover Borough to Bull Road will be collected this week.

The Dover Township Brush Crew

Brush collection guide for curbside pick up

These guides have been developed by the rules of the processing companies where we take your brush. Also, some of the rules have been developed to give us the ability to handle and load your brush onto our truck. Some of the rules help us eliminate damaging your property.

Some are developed to lower the costs of brush collection. And some are to create better safety conditions for our crews working on busy roadways.

When using the brush drop area. Please apply the appropriate rules to the brush drop off area. (Marked with*)

Guide #1 Size and distances

- Branches must be cut to a length 8' or less and a diameter of 10" or less. *
- Brush piles that are placed parallel to the street are much easier to pick up with our equipment.
- When placing your brush pile at the curb make sure the rear of the brush pile is no more than 10' from the edge of the roadway.

Guide #2 Eligible and ineligible materials

- Fall grass, grass clippings and Bamboo will not be accepted by the brush processing company. *
- We cannot collect it with the brush. *
- Shrubbery can be collected but only if the root ball is removed. *

Guide #3 Safety

- Safety rules to protect our work crews include flagging busy roads or roads with blind spots.
- Collecting your brush requires us to use large equipment which causes us to close the roadway for a short period of time. Please be patient and follow the directions of the flaggers.

Guide #4 Brush Drop Area

- Dover Township provides a brush drop off area. This drop off area is located to the rear of the Township Office 2480 West Canal Road.
- Drop off operation are the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month and is open from 7:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

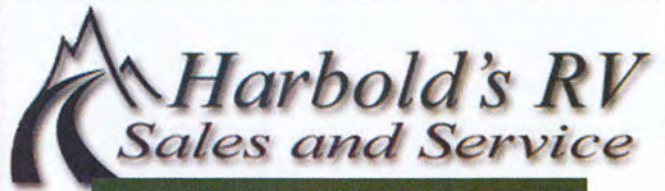

DOVER TOWNSHIP RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Acceptable Items— Aluminum food and beverage containers, Glass food and beverage containers—brown, clear or green, Bi-Metal, Steel and Aerosol cans, PET Plastic Containers with the symbol #1 narrow neck containers only, HDPE Plastic containers with the symbol #2 narrow neck containers such as milk and water bottles, detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles, etc. without caps, Plastics with symbols #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 narrow and screw top containers, Newsprint, Cardboard—flattened in 2'x2' bundles (may be placed in recycling bin along other recycling), Residential mixed paper (Junk Mail, Magazines, Telephone Books, Printer/Copier Paper) Cereal Boxes.

Non-Acceptable Items— Window or Auto Glass, Drinking Glasses, Mirrors, Light Bulbs, Ceramic, Porcelain, Microwave Trays, Glass Cookware/Bakeware, Unnumbered Plastic Items, Plastic Bags, Salad/Deli Containers, Shredded Paper, Plastic Food Tubs, Household Items such as cooking pots, Batteries, Cardboard/Paper with wax coating or liners, Scrap Metal, Siding.

The Tip of the Season.....

Preparing for Flooding and Heavy Rains

Flash floods occur within six hours of the beginning of heavy rainfall. Below are some guidelines for keeping safe during a flash flood:

Power Outages: CALL YOUR ELECTRIC COMPANAY FIRST!
EMA tracks power outages on [www.24/7 power outage](http://www.24/7poweroutage.com).

- Go to high ground immediately.
- Get out of areas subject to flooding, such as low spots, canyons, washes, etc.
- Do not attempt to cross a flowing stream on foot. Even water only six inches deep, when moving at a high rate of speed, can knock you off your feet.
- Never drive through flooded areas or standing water. Shallow, swiftly flowing water can wash a car from a roadway. Also, the roadbed may not be intact under the water.
- If the vehicle stalls, abandon it immediately and seek higher ground. Rapidly rising water may engulf the vehicle and its occupants.
- Be especially cautious at night when it's harder to recognize flood dangers.
- Do not camp or park your vehicle along streams and washes, particularly during threatening conditions.

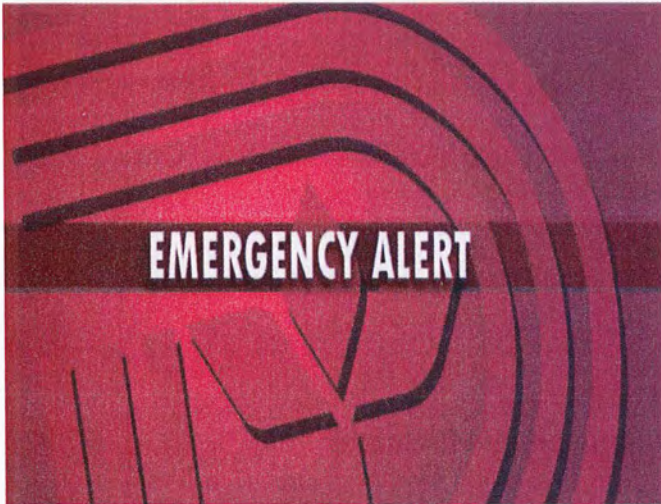

The York County West Nile Virus Program performs mosquito surveillance and response in accordance with CDC and PA Department of Environmental Protection procedures and recommendations to reduce the risk of West Nile Virus, Zika Virus and other potential mosquito vector diseases. The most common sources of high mosquito populations in residential areas continue to be human made sources from something as large as an unmaintained swimming pool to yard clutter (tires, tarps, garden equipment) and illegal dumping, trash and litter. Residents, farmers, businesses, municipalities and school districts can greatly reduce mosquito concerns and related human health risk by cleaning up their own property and supporting local community cleanups.

Take time to learn all you can about preventing mosquitoes and reducing your family's risk to related diseases!
