TOWNSHIP BUILDING ADDITION PROJECT PROGRESS:

Our contractors have been on site since the first week of April. If you have visited or traveled past our building you will see that demolition is well under way, including the removal of the front walls and roof of our oldest garage area. The interior first floor including the reception area, board meeting room, bathrooms, locker rooms and storage rooms have been through the demolition phase as well. Second floor offices in the administrative portion of the building immediately adjacent to the garage space were relocated elsewhere in the building to accommodate the remainder of the roof being removed in that area. We are presently without any indoor meeting spaces other than the office trailer's extra office. In the coming weeks we anticipate finalization of the demolition work, site work preparation, and the beginning of the new addition's construction. Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority guidance for operational decisions is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month **AS NEEDED**. Please check www.dovertownship.org for details and updates on scheduled meetings.

Your toilet is not a trashcan:

Tossing so-called "flushable" wipes, paper towels, tissues, tampons, and other dense paper materials into the toilet could end up costing you quite a bundle. These items do not biodegrade easily or quickly. Wipes, feminine hygiene products, and other paper materials can get stuck in the narrow sanitary sewer service lateral that connects homes and businesses to the city's wastewater collection system. And if grease or other congealing products are poured down the kitchen sink, these attach to the wipes, causing "fatbergs" to form. You end up paying the price:

The result can be clogged pipes, sewage back-ups into homes, and potentially expensive repairs. Even if these materials make it through your property's private sewer service lateral, they can cause problems down the line. If you can throw it in the trash, don't put it in the toilet or drain.

The answer:

If you can throw it in the trash, do throw it in the trash. Tissue paper, wipes, cotton swabs, paper towels, dental floss, condoms, any kind of cloth, cosmetics, and any kind of feminine hygiene product all belong in the trash. The only things that belong in the toilet are the two "P"s and the TP: poop, pee and toilet paper.





Northern York County Regional PoliceImage: Second Project Lifesaver

Project Lifesaver provides law enforcement with a program designed to protect, and when necessary, quickly locate individuals with cognitive disorders who are prone to the life-threatening behavior of wandering. The necessity of this program was determined through the correlation between cognitive conditions and the act of wandering. The program has grown from a localized program to a program recognized internationally as a proven and effective method of "bringing loved one's home."

The method relies on proven radio technology and specially trained search and rescue teams. Citizens enrolled in Project Lifesaver wear a small transmitter on the wrist or ankle that emits an individualized frequency signal. If an enrolled client goes missing, the caregiver notifies their local Project Lifesaver agency, and a trained emergency team responds to the wanderer's area. The first responders will then use the client's individualized frequency to locate the position of the individual.

The Northern York County Regional Police Department has nine officers trained in the operation of the Project Lifesaver Program. Four of these officers are School Resource Officers.

If you are a Parent, Guardian or Caregiver of an individual that is at risk of wandering away and you feel they should be enrolled in the Project Lifesaver Program please visit www.nycrpd.org and complete the information on the Project Lifesaver Page located on the right side of the home page.

If you don't believe that your loved one is a wandering risk but would like to provide the NYCRPD with information about their at risk or special circumstances, please visit www.nycrpd.org and complete the information on the At Risk Individual / Special Circumstances Page located on the right side of the home page.

Proper Cart Placement

Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The garbage truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your cans.

Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- Set mobile cart out the evening before pickup day.
- Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
- Do not place cart in the roadway.
- Do not block walkways with carts.
- Place carts at least THREE FEET APART from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS – Appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied).

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Electronic devices, chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/ industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Bulk items will be collected by appointment only. Please call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection. Appliances with Freon must be scheduled with Penn Waste. Items include but are not limited to air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.

In Dover Township, property owners are required to submit a completed York County Sludge/Septage Manifest Report within 30 days following a septic system pumping. This documentation is essential for compliance with the Township's Sewage Management Program Ordinance, aimed at protecting groundwater and ensuring systems are maintained. And also helps maintain accurate records for system maintenance and planning purposes. Your Septic is required to be pumped every 4 years in Dover Township.
